

RESOLUTION NO. 60-2022 (AS), *First Reading*

A Resolution appointing Councilor Josie Moore to the Doan Brook Watershed Partnership Board of Trustees.

WHEREAS, in 1974, the Cities of Cleveland Heights, Shaker Heights and Cleveland, with interested citizens, formed a Joint Committee on the Doan Brook Watershed; and

WHEREAS, in 2002, the Doan Brook Watershed Partnership was formed as a 501(c)(3) non-profit entity governed by a 14-to-16-member Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Regulations of the Doan Brook Watershed Partnership authorize this Council to appoint one of its members to serve as a member of the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to appoint Councilor Josie Moore to the Doan Brook Watershed Partnership Board of Trustees, pursuant to the Regulations.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cleveland Heights, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. This Council appoints Cleveland Heights Councilor Josie Moore to the Doan Brook Watershed Partnership Board of Trustees.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be given by publishing the title and abstract of its contents, prepared by the Director of Law, once in one newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cleveland Heights.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
