Suggested Questions for Council and Administration

1. What parts of the Charter should be considered by the Commission, without necessarily implying that you believe a change should or should not be made.

The three (3) most important elements for consideration, not necessarily in order of importance to you.

Any remaining elements, preferably in order of importance to you.

2. For each part identified in Question 1, explain briefly,
 - (a) why the item should be considered and if you think a change may be warranted, then
 - (b) what the change should be and why.
3. Identify any particular change or changes you have observed in the facts and circumstances of the city (other than personnel changes in the City Council or City Administration) in the five (5) years since the on-cycle determination by Council in 2012 that no charter review was warranted, that warrant this off-cycle review, and how any such changes relate to what you noted in Questions 1 and 2 above.
