

RESOLUTION NO. 107-2023(MSES), *First Reading*

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Bell Equipment Company through the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program for the acquisition of a compactor/rear loader for the Division of Refuse Collection for the Department of Public Works; providing compensation therefor; and declaring the necessity that this legislation become immediately effective as an emergency measure.

WHEREAS, in order to meet operational needs, it is necessary to purchase a new compactor/rear loader for Division of Refuse Collection of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, Section 171.12 of the Cleveland Heights Codified Ordinances authorizes the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies, and other articles through the National Joint Powers Alliance cooperative purchasing program without obtaining competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined that a TAC 750 Terex Chipper may be purchased through the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program (fka National Joint Powers Alliance purchasing program) at a lower price than could be obtained through bidding, and that it would be in the City's best interests to purchase said vehicle by this means.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cleveland Heights, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute any and all agreements necessary for the purchase of a 25 Yard Heil DuraPack 500 High Compaction Rear Loader Bell from Equipment Company through the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program, in accordance with the requirements of Section 171.12 of the Cleveland Heights Codified Ordinances for a price not to exceed Two Hundred Forty-nine Thousand, Six Hundred Thirty-eight and 10/100 Dollars (\$249,638.10). All contracts hereunder shall be in a form approved by the Director of Law.

SECTION 2. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be given by publishing the title and abstract of its contents, prepared by the Director of Law, once in one newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cleveland Heights.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective as an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Cleveland Heights, such emergency being the obtain necessary equipment so the Department of Public Works may carry out its duties and functions. Wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) or more of the members elected or appointed to this Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
