RESOLUTION NO. 125-2023(PSH), *First Reading*

A Resolution amending Resolution No. 21-2020 to extend the term of an agreement with the Cuyahoga County Board of Health for a grant for lead remediation work in dwelling units in the City of Cleveland Heights; and declaring the necessity that this legislation become immediately effective as an emergency measure.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development previously entered into an agreement with the Cuyahoga County Board of Health for the provision of grant funds under the Lead Hazard Remediation Grant Program for lead remediation work in dwelling units; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 21-2020, the Cuyahoga County Board of Health entered into an agreement with the City whereby the City, as sub-grantee, performed such lead remediation work in dwelling units in the City of Cleveland Heights; and

WHEREAS, due to pandemic restrictions the City was unable to expend all the funding; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the parties to extend the term of said Agreement for an additional year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cleveland Heights, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Resolution No. 21-2020 shall be and hereby amended to authorize the Mayor to sign an amendment to the agreement with the Cuyahoga County Board of Health for lead remediation work to extend the term there for an additional year, so that the term expires on September 20, 2024. All other terms of the agreement not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect. The amendment to the agreement shall be approved as to form by and subject to the final approval of the Director of Law.

SECTION 2. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be given by publishing the title and abstract of its contents, prepared by the Director of Law, once in one newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cleveland Heights.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective as an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Cleveland Heights, such emergency being the need to meet County deadlines. Wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) or more

of the members elected or appointed to this Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
