Part 1:

C&GS Review and Revision

It was proposed that we send a packet of documentation to council:

Note: Including stormwater aligns C&GS with environmental policy - Climate Action plan

- Expanded the definition of “complete and green streets” to include streets, trails, sidewalks, and pathways. Re-established that any work within the public right-of-way is under Complete and Green Streets. Added NOACA to 3.3 of Section 3, “tree canopy,” and “green infrastructure” to 3.4 of Section 3, and Public Works to the stakeholder list. All three bodies being at the table removes the need for city council to make a decision. Added “The City of Cleveland Division of Water” to 5.2.

Streets are picked early on, (August will know roads for 2026) and Director Clinkscale will attend

Next steps:

Make a presentation for COW City Council meeting

Council will not vote at that meeting, C&GS will go to Law Dept first then it gets voted on by council
