

Public Meeting – January 24, 2019

Following more than a year of work, the Cleveland Heights Charter Review Commission has developed a number of recommended changes to the City's **Charter**, all of which have been incorporated into a draft **First Amended Charter**. Upon completion of its work, the Commission will present recommendations to the City Council for its consideration.

Before determining for certain what the full and final recommendations will be, the Commission will host a public meeting at which interested residents are invited to provide oral comments concerning the proposed amended charter. The meeting will take place at the Cleveland Heights Community Center on Thursday, January 24, 2019, at 7:00 PM.
